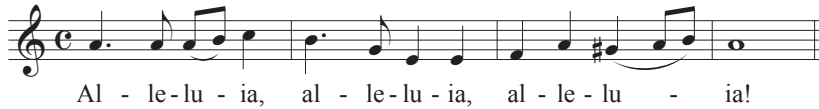

Priest: The Lord be with you.

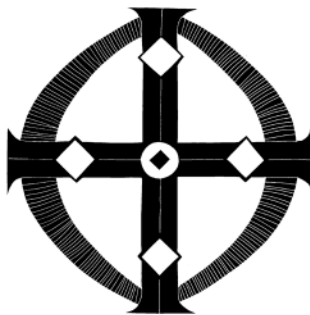
Assembly: **And with your spirit.**

Priest: May he rest in peace.

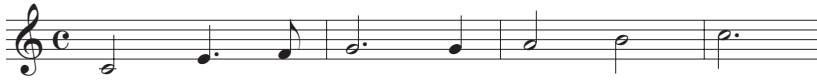

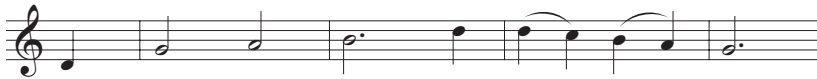
